The Assisi Loop Mechanism of Action





Assisi tPEMF delivers 100% of its PEMF dose to enhance NO signaling. The bar graph shows other PEMF devices deliver lower doses to this pathway. This means the Loop can reduce pain faster, and therefore more efficiently, than every other PEMF device available for veterinary use.

Assisi Loop Controls Swelling 61% Better — Without Drugs



The Carageenan injection model used here is a standard model used by many drug and device companies to measure pain control. Here the group treated with the active device demonstrated 61% less swelling compared to the group treated with a sham device at 8 hours. Swelling was measured by volume using the Archimedes method. The p value is equal to 0.003, meaning highly significant.

Assisi's tPEMF signal was specifically configured to target the Nitric Oxide (NO) signaling pathway. Thus, the Assisi Loop delivers 100% of its dose to NO signaling, with no extraneous side effects. No other PEMF signal has been purposely configured in this manner. As a result, other PEMF devices deliver lower doses to the NO pathway and cannot reduce pain or inflammation as rapidly or effectively as the Assisi Loop.


